Pullman & Comley attorney Brad N. Mondschein was quoted in an article in the February 22, 2010, *Connecticut Law Tribune*, "Smart Phone Users Call Sales Tax Dumb Idea," about recent lawsuits alleging that AT&T is illegally charging sales tax on Internet use for their cellular service.

"AT&T will claim that accessing your e-mail uses Internet protocol technology but is not accessing the quote, unquote Internet," said Brad. "So the question is, is a data plan accessing the Internet and therefore not subject to sales tax?"
