Attorney David Atkins, chair of Pullman & Comley's Professional Liability practice, was referenced in a Bloomberg Law "Big Law Business" article entitled "Michael Cohen's Troubles Don't End with His Guilty Plea," which discussed whether Cohen's guilty pleas to tax fraud and campaign finance violations would subject him to professional discipline, apart from criminal penalties.
